Reminiscent of Gypsum crystals this design is formed organically with layers of paint, representing the natural intricacy of mineral formation.

Fromental wallcoverings are hand-made to order. Each panel is exclusively created to fit clients' specifications. From supplied elevations and floor plan we will calculate the amount of wallcovering required to ensure optimal installation.

Technical Information

Design and Installation

This all-over design is hand-painted onto individual silk panels, therefore the design will not join across panel seams. However, joins are usually well hidden within the complex pattern of the design. This is illustrated in the visual on the right. It is important to note that Gypsum colourways are created using a combination of silk and paint, therefore silk colour is integral to the overall colourway.

Material and Technique

Hand-painted on paper backed silk.

Dimensions

Height - Panels are supplied 300mm/12" higher than specified wall height. Standard panel height is up to 4300mm/14ft. Panels over the standard height are available with a surcharge.

Width - Standard panel width 915mm/36" plus 15mm/1/2" trim.
