Material and Technique

Hand-painted on tea paper.

Dimensions

Height - Panels are supplied 150mm/6" higher than specified wall height. Standard panel height is up to 4300mm/14ft. Taller panels are available with a surcharge.

Width - Standard panel width 915mm/36" plus 15mm/ 1/2" trim.
