


The British Aesthetic Movement owes much of its inspiration to the art of Japan. Kiku draws from both Japanese art and Europe's infatuation with the form.

Technical Information


Material and Technique Hand-painted onto paper-backed silk.

Dimensions

Height - Panels are supplied 300mm/12" higher than specified wall height. Standard panel height is up to 4300mm/14ft. Taller panels are available with a surcharge.


Width - Standard panel width 915mm/36" plus 15mm/ ½" trim.
